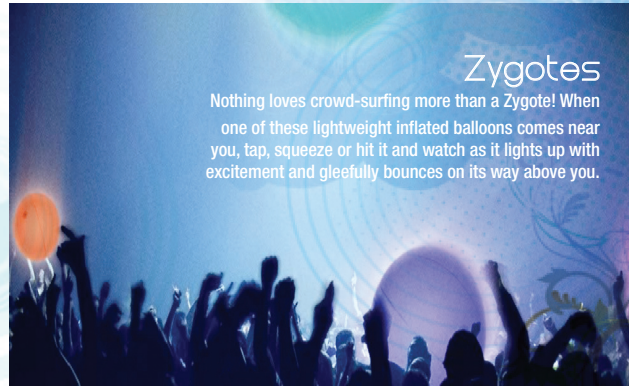
### Mondo Spider

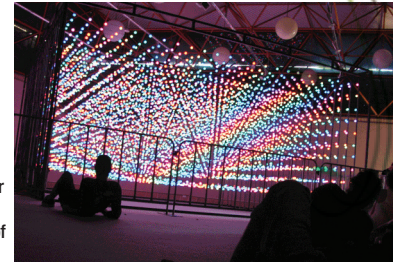


### Zygotes
